PURPOSE OF JOB

The Welfare Coach forms a key part of SOAR's Social Prescribing Service delivered in partnership with Primary Care Networks, housing and VCSE organisations. Working intensively with clients who have a range of complex needs, the role will:

- Provide tailored practical support to help individuals navigate various housing processes, i.e. housing registration, bidding policy
- Co-ordinate, simplify and broker access to a range of housing, health and social support based on the needs and wishes of the individual
- Provide support around applying for housing related benefits i.e. Housing benefit, council tax support, discretionary housing payment, etc
- Co-produce a personalised support plan that encourages the empowerment of an individual to take control of their own household needs and therefore maintain a tenancy
- Connect individuals to local and city-wide services
- Develop close working partnerships with health, social care, housing and voluntary, community or social enterprise (VCSE) organisations.
